

"The year has just flu by"

The vaccination season, suddenly seemed to be upon us, and back in September work was well underway to organise and administer the clinics...

In times gone by, many of us will remember coming along on Saturday morning for our annual flu jab, to keep us as healthy as possible through the winter flu season...

Then the world got turned upside down as a new word entered our vocabulary, that word or phrase was Covid-19.

Now the practice are having to administer both jabs, and this year the booster vaccination was either Pfizer or Moderna, both of which must be keep at very low temperatures and once "thawed" have to be used within a few hours!

Fortunately, here at our practice, we have some very skilled people who can sort all this complicated system out!

In the last few months, the practice has given out 6983 Covid boosters and 7201 flu vaccinations. Many (like me) had both at the same time, one in each arm...

Included in this figure are the vaccinations that were given to people both in Westhoughton and Blackrod that are vulnerable and housebound. Driver volunteers helped by taking nurses to these people so as to be able to vaccinate as many people as possible in each session.

Volunteers were also involved with all the clinics helping on the car parks, in the queues, directing people inside the surgery, without these volunteers, the numbers that were vaccinated could not have been achieved.

A huge thank you and well done to our band of volunteers, who just give up their time, to help for no reward at all.... You are all just brilliant!
